## A RESOLUTION OF THE HARTSTENE POINTE WATER-SEWER DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ESTABLISHING A GREENHOUSE GAS POLICY

WHEREAS, RCW 70.235.070 requires entities receiving the State funds for infrastructure and economic development projects to have adopted policies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Trust Fund requires the entity to have a Greenhouse Gas Policy as a prerequisite for Public works Trust Fund Loans; now

## THEREFORE the Board of Commissioners of the Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District hereby resolves:

- 1. Energy conservation practices shall be encouraged in the District buildings and operations.
- 2. Energy conservation practices shall be encouraged by raising the awareness of employees and contract operator's energy use.
- 3. Reduce greenhouse gases by expanding the use of conservation and alternative energy sources.
- 4. Publicize water conservation.
- 5. Establish a tier rate structure for water use to encourage conservation.
