RESOLUTION 2014-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE HARTSTENE POINTE WATER-SEWER DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS, AND ORDERING CERTAIN WORK.

WHEREAS, the Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District, a special purpose district, is authorized by RCW 57.08.050 to perform public works after waiving competitive bidding requirements in certain limited circumstances; and

WHEREAS, an inoperable drain valve within the wastewater treatment plant has failed in a partially open position, requiring a bypass of the sequential batch reactor, resulting in the plant not functioning according to design and compromising the quality of the effluent being discharged into the Puget Sound;

THEREFORE, The Board of Commissioners of the Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District hereby resolves:

- 1. That an emergency exists.
- 2. That this unforeseen circumstance presents a real, immediate threat to the proper performance of essential functions.
- 3. That competitive bidding requirements are waived for repair of the drain valve under authority granted by RCW 57.08.050.
- 4. That the District's General Manager is directed to negotiate an agreement with a responsible contractor to excavate and repair or replace the drain valve.
